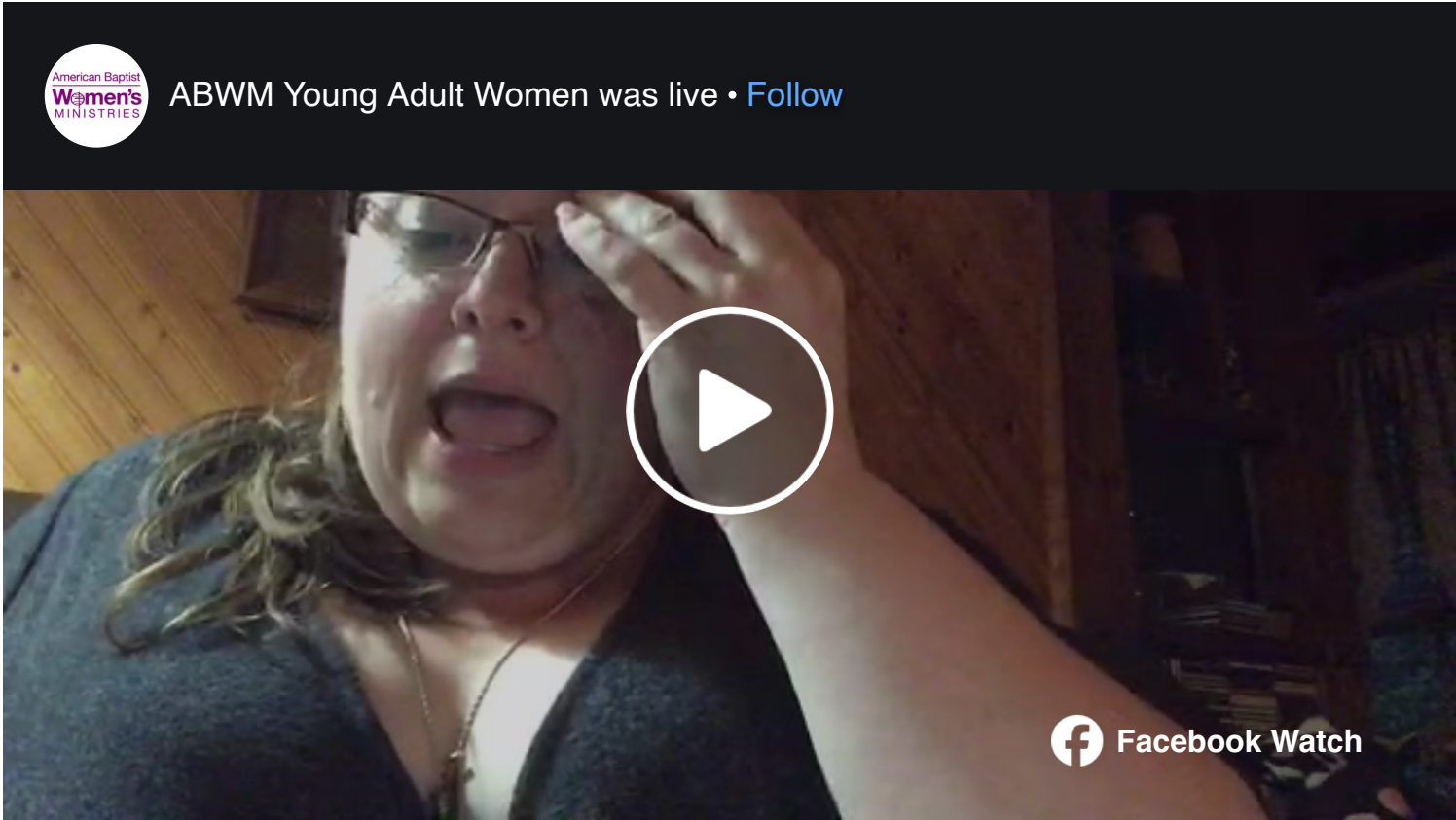
Bible Study on Isaiah 11:9 with Jami Robertson

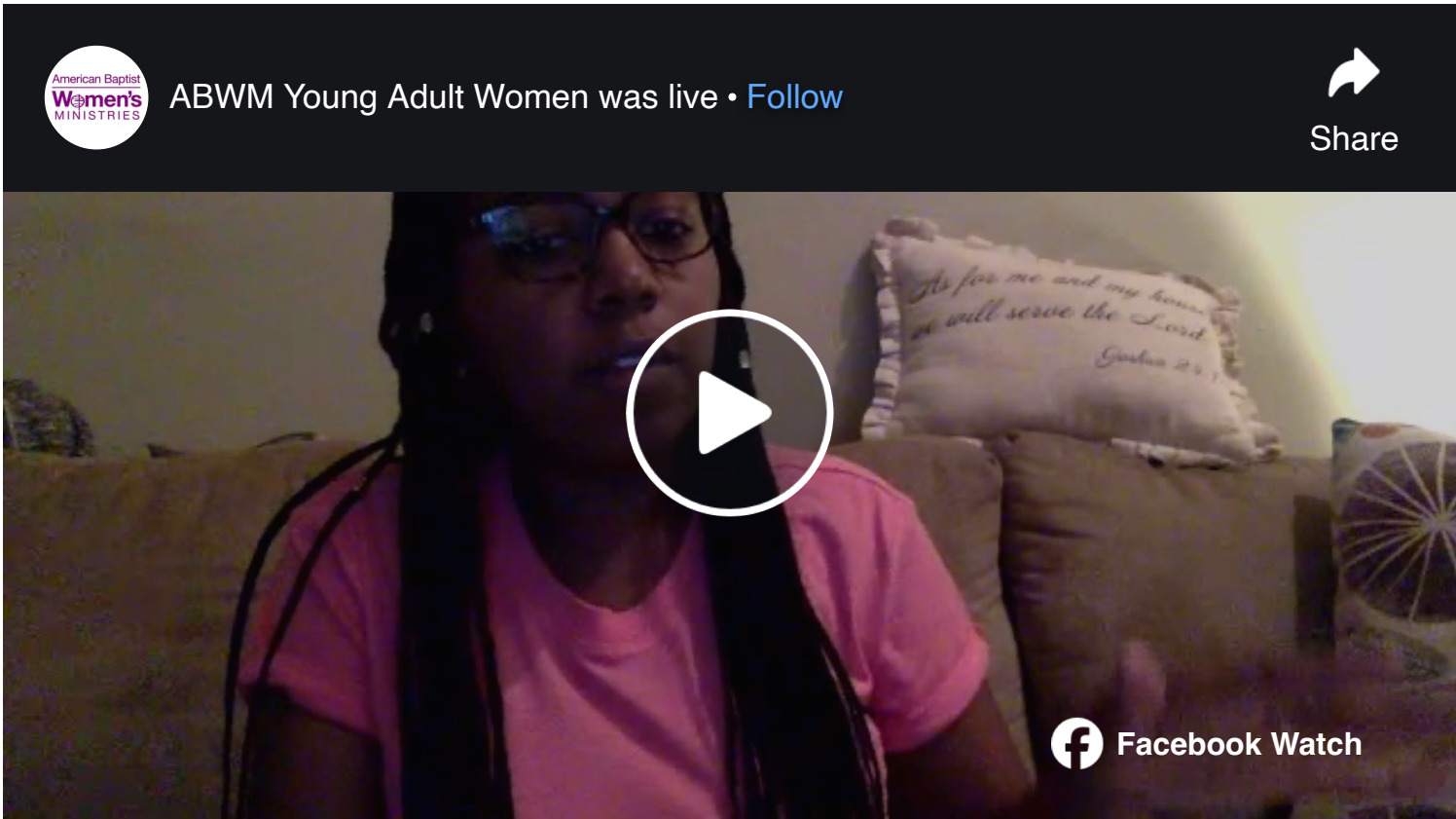
Bible Study on 1 Samuel 2:1-11 (The Voice) with September Schaffer
